Texas Health and Human Services Commission Under Sunset Review

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) and HHSC Enterprise is currently undergoing review by the **Texas Sunset Commission.** The Sunset Commission's recommendations, **available here**, include recommendations related to streamlining Medicaid enrollment and credentialing, and consolidating the state women's health programs. TACHC submitted comments related to consolidating women's health programs (attached) and will be testifying at an upcoming legislative hearing.
