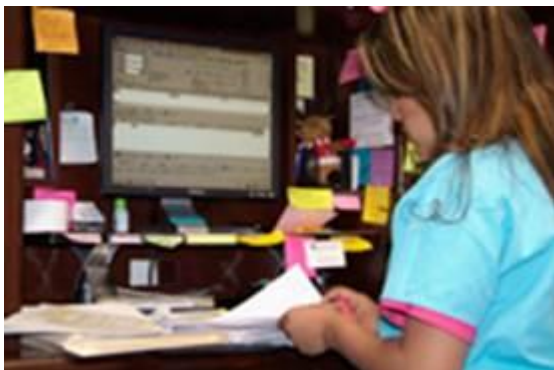

1. HHSC Community Partner Program Enrollment: Due to HRSA's recent announcement about the availability of Outreach & Enrollment funds for health centers to increase in-reach, as well as outreach activities, it is even more critical that your health center sign up for the [Community Partner Program](#). Both CMS and HHSC are advocating for online systems to facilitate enrollment in affordable insurance coverage either through the Marketplace and/or CHIP and Medicaid. This is also a prerequisite if you are a participating health center in TACHC's proposal for the CMS Federal Navigator grant. Open enrollment for the federal health exchanges begins October 1st; therefore, it is important to get your health center signed up for the Community Partner Program *now* to be onboard and ready to utilize both systems. To submit your request, simply fill out an [online interest form](#). If you have more than one site that you would like to sign up, please be aware that **a separate interest form will be needed for each site**. IMPORTANT: Housing Policy

In an effort to ensure that our hotel is able to accept the maximum number of reservations, TACHC has implemented the following housing policies:

- Each reservation must have a unique name attached to it. No person may book more than one room in his/her name.
- A deposit of one night's room and tax will be taken at the time of booking in order to guarantee your reservation.
- Should you need to cancel, cancellations must be made 15 days in advance in order to be refunded your deposit.
- Cancellations within 15 days prior to your arrival date, deposits are non-refundable unless the hotel is able to resell your canceled room.

GlaxoSmithKline Shortage of Fluarix (PFS) Flu Vaccine: TACHC has just been notified by GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) that they are experiencing a shortage of their Fluarix (PFS) flu vaccine for pre-book reservations for the 2013-14 flu season. The shortage does NOT apply for Fluarix Quadrivalent or FluLaval. The official letter from GSK is attached for your reference. If you have not yet heard from your GSK representative on this matter, please contact them immediately. Please remember that TACHC does have a flu vaccine contract with Novartis for their Fluvirin (MDV is still available for pre-booking). Subject: Novartis's Fluvirin

TACHC now has available the Novartis seasonal influenza vaccine for the **2013/14 flu season: Fluvirin**. The highlights of the pricing are as follows:

- For all purchases of Fluvirin the purchase price payable for Fluvirin under the 340Better program shall be \$96.90 per 10-dose vial and \$106.30 per packet of 10 pre-filled syringes (in each case excluding excise tax).
- For purchases of Fluvirin direct from Novartis Vaccines, the following terms shall apply:
 1. Members may order Fluvirin via Novartis Vaccines' website at www.novartisvaccinesdirect.com or by phone at 877-NV-DIRECT (877-683-4732). Once a member orders Fluvirin from Novartis Vaccines, the order is "firm" and may not be canceled by the member.
 2. For each order of Fluvirin placed **on or before June 1, 2013**, the purchase price payable by the member shall be \$77.52 per 10-dose vial and \$85.04 per packet of 10 pre-filled syringes (in each case excluding excise tax), which reflects a twenty percent (20%) discount from the applicable purchase price mentioned above.
 3. For each order of Fluvirin placed on or before June 1, 2013, twenty percent (20%) of the aggregate number of doses of Fluvirin subject to such order may be returned.
 4. For each order placed **after June 1, 2013**, no doses subject to such order may be returned. All doses subject to return as set forth above shall be returned to Novartis Vaccines or its designee by the purchasing member on or before March 31, 2014 (at the member's cost and expense) in accordance with Novartis Vaccines' instructions. Each member shall remain obligated to pay for all doses, including doses returned to Novartis Vaccines. Upon its receipt of any doses properly returned, Novartis Vaccines shall provide to the member a number of doses of replacement product for the 2014-2015 influenza season, free of charge, equal to the number of doses returned by the member.
 5. Payment for doses of Fluvirin purchased by members shall be due and payable within 60 days of delivery and members shall be entitled to a 2% prompt payment discount off of the final invoice price paid after applying all other applicable discounts for payments timely made on or before such due date.

Subject: IMPORTANT UPDATE on pre-book reservations of FLUARIX[®] (Influenza Virus Vaccine) for the 2013-2014 influenza season

Dear Ms. Lynn Ford – Texas Association of Community Health Centers:

On behalf of GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) Vaccines, I would like to notify you that GSK is experiencing a supply shortage of FLUARIX for the 2013-2014 influenza pre-book reservations. As a result, GSK is notifying most direct-purchase customers that we will not be able to fulfill their pre-book reservations for this product.* (FLUARIX is the GSK trivalent influenza vaccine, supplied in prefilled syringes.)

This shortage does **not** apply to FLUARIX[®] QUADRIVALENT (Influenza Virus Vaccine) or FLULAVAL[®] (Influenza Virus Vaccine).

The supply of FLUARIX has been adjusted because of limits on our prefilled syringe manufacturing capacity for all GSK vaccines. In part, this is due to the response for the shortage of combination DTaP in the US.[†] GSK is prioritizing the manufacture of its DTaP primary series vaccine in prefilled syringes.


With this GSK decision, we believe that the overall influenza supply for the 2013-2014 influenza season will still meet the US public health and market needs.

Unfortunately, as a result of this difficult decision, FLUARIX supply for most customers is limited. While it is possible that we will ultimately be able to offer a limited number of additional doses of FLUARIX later in the season, we are encouraging customers to pursue alternative sources of influenza vaccines for the 2013-2014 influenza season. We are providing our customers with a list of influenza vaccine distributors who have indicated they may have influenza vaccine available. We hope that by communicating this information to customers as early as possible, customers will have time to find an alternative source of vaccine for the upcoming season.

I want to extend my sincerest apologies for the inconveniences and challenges that your members may encounter due to the reduced supply of FLUARIX for the 2013-2014 influenza season.
